

Extended Cookies Policy

What are cookies?

"Cookies" are small software tags which are stored on your computer by the Internet browser, retaining only information related to your preferences, not including, as such, your personal data.

What are Cookies for?

Cookies are used to help determine the usefulness, interest and number of uses of your websites, resulting in faster and more efficient navigation, eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information.

What type of cookies do we use?

Two groups of cookies can be used:

Permanent cookies: cookies which are stored in the browser on your access devices (PC, mobile and tablet) and are used whenever you newly visit one of our websites. They are generally used to direct navigation according to the user's interests, enabling us to provide a more personalised service.

Session cookies: temporary cookies which remain in your browser's cookie file until you leave the website. The information obtained by these cookies is used to analyse traffic patterns on the web, enabling us to identify problems and provide a better browsing experience.

For what purposes do we use cookies?

Strictly necessary cookies

They allow you to browse the website and use its applications, as well as access secure areas of the website. Without these cookies, the services you have requested cannot be provided.

Analytical Cookies

They are used anonymously for the purpose of creating and analysing statistics, in order to improve website functionality.

Functionality Cookies

They save the user's preferences relative to the website's use, so that it is not necessary to reconfigure the website each time you visit it.

Third-Party Cookies

They measure the success of applications and the effectiveness of third-party advertising. They can also be used to customise a widget with user data.

Advertising Cookies

They target advertising according to the interests of each user, to target advertising campaigns by taking into consideration users' tastes, and, in addition, they limit the number of times the ad is visualised, helping to measure the effectiveness of advertising and the success of the website's organisation.

How can you manage cookies?

All browsers allow the user to accept, refuse or delete cookies, namely by selecting the appropriate settings in the respective browser. You can configure cookies in your browser's "options" or "preferences" menu.

However, please note that by disabling cookies, some web services may not function correctly, thereby, affecting, partially or totally, browsing on the website.

What happens when cookies are disabled?
